Introduction

Thanks for purchasing Web Studio. This is documentation for version 1.3, a new update which introduces:

- New design built upon Bootstrap 3
- Integration with the Altusia admin panel
- Improved tools
- New bug fixes

Installation

The installation process is rather simple, and short, thanks to the Altusia Installer. To begin, locate the “Distribution” folder inside this downloaded zip file.

Open the “Distribution” folder, and you will see a directory labeled “install”. Now, find the place where you want to install Web Studio. Upload the “install” directory (and all of its contents) to that location.

The application will be installed into the directory where you uploaded the installer. Next, open your web browser and navigate to the install directory. You will see the following screen:

With this license, You may not sell access or require payment for users to be able to use the application. You may also not transfer the license to any other party. The *Extended License* allows you to create a single (one) end product using this software, for You or a client. However, with this license you can sell access or require payment for users to be able to use the application. You may not transfer the license to any other party.

Accept

The rest is simple. Read the End User License Agreement (it’s not too long, please read it). If you agree, hit Accept. If there’s something you don’t like, please contact me at bailey.herbert@hotmail.com and we’ll see what we can work out.

The next step will check your system for basic requirements. When it’s done, you’ll be redirected to a configuration page, where you choose the admin email and admin password.

When you’re done, the system will install. It should take no more than 2-3 seconds. You will be navigated to the finished application when it’s ready.

Finishing up

Now that the installation is done, you should log into the admin panel (using the email and password you provided during the installation process). Go ahead and configure your settings.
